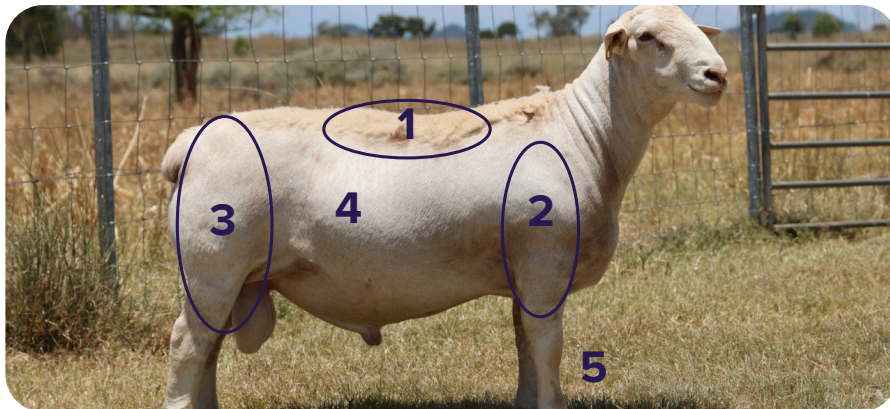


WHITE DORPER

A shedding meat sheep developed for Australian conditions, valued for hardiness, fertility and efficient lamb production.



Breed highlights

1. Broad loin: Wide, juice loin for better carcase yield
2. Deep body capacity: Deep, long body for increased capacity and better growth
3. Hindquarter muscling: Well developed muscle in the hindquarter for maximum meat yield
4. Shedding coat: Short, hair coat naturally sheds seasonally, reducing shearing costs and improving welfare
5. Strong feet and legs: Strong, sound structure for mobility and longevity in tough conditions

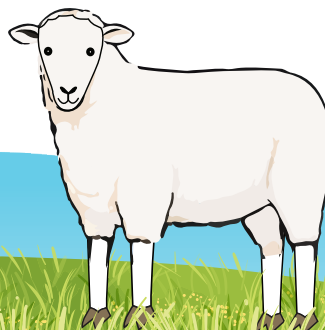

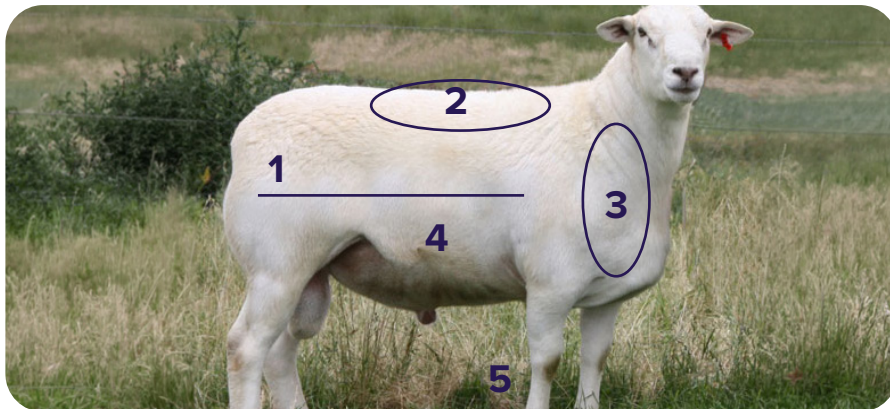

AUSSIE WHITE

An Australian shedding breed developed for easy care meat production with strong growth and parasite resilience.



Breed highlights

1. Long body length: Longer body for greater carcase potential and higher lean meat yield
2. Broad loin: Wide, meaty loin for better carcase shape and high yield
3. Smooth muscle pattern: Even, natural muscling through the shoulder, loin and hindquarter for lean, high quality lamb
4. Clean shedding coat: Short, clean shedding coat reduces shearing costs and improves animal welfare
5. Strong feet and legs: Sound structure and strong feet for durability, mobility and longevity in all conditions

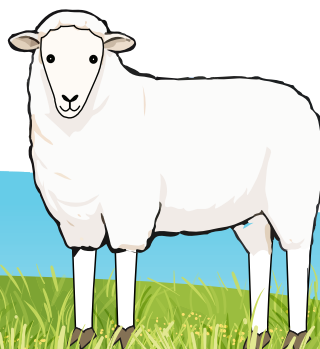

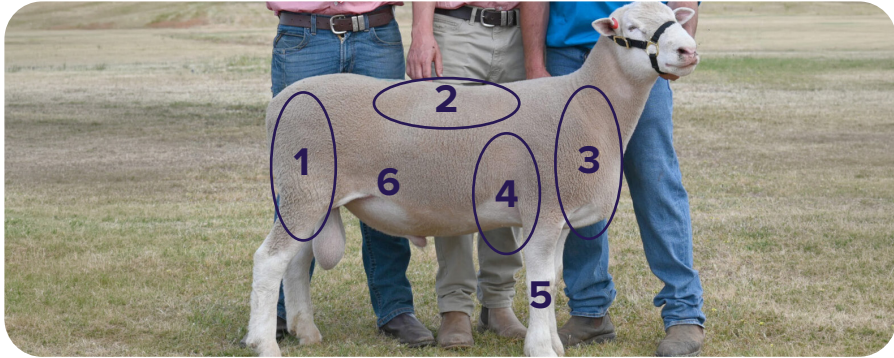

POLL DORSET

1. Thick hindquarter: Well developed muscle in the hindquarter for maximum growth, power and carcase yield
2. Deep, wide loin: A deep, wide loin provides excellent carcase shape and high yielding lambs
3. Broad shoulder: A wide, thick shoulder sets the foundation for early growth and heavy muscling
4. Depth of body: Deep body capacity supports growth, feed efficiency and strong carcase performance
5. Wide stance and strong legs: A wide stance and strong bone structure support weight, mobility and structural soundness.
6. Downs Wool: Ideal for its density and springiness

Breed highlights

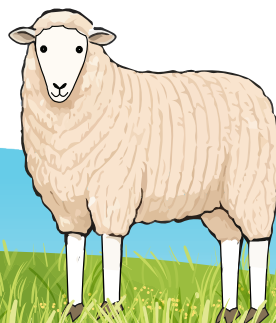
1. Excellent maternal structure: Feminine head, wide pelvis and strong udder support excellent mothering ability and lamb survival

4. Excellent milk production: Well attached udders with good capacity and teat placement to rear strong, fast growing lambs

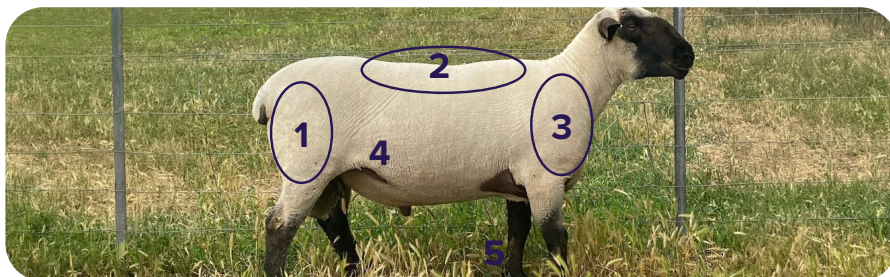

3. Strong topline: A strong, level topline shows structural strength and supports growth, muscling and longevity
4. Early maturity and fast growth: Hampshire down lambs mature early and finish fast, maximising efficiency and profit in prime lamb systems
5. Strong feet and legs: Sound structure and strong feet support mobility, longevity and performance in all conditions

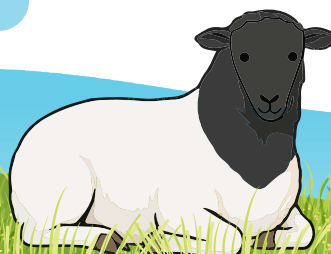

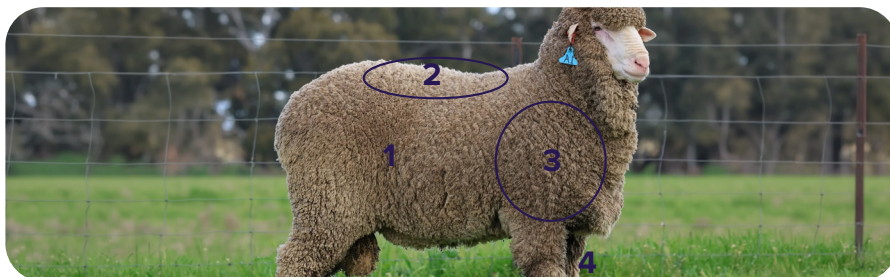

POLL MERINO

The Merino is one of Australia's most important sheep breeds. While best known for fine wool, Merino ewes form the maternal foundation of many crossbreeding systems that produce productive first-cross ewes and profitable prime lambs.



Breed highlights

1. Fine wool fleece: Dense, high quality fleece producing valuable wool income
2. Deep body capacity: Good body depth supports pregnancy, grazing efficiency and lamb rearing ability
3. Strong maternal structure: Feminine structure and good constitution support lamb survival and productivity
4. Strong feet and legs: Sound structure support mobility and long term flock productivity
